The Jacksonville Women's Business Center (JWBC) is a program of the Jacksonville Chamber Foundation, Inc., a 501(c)3 non-profit organization. JWBC is partially funded by a cooperative agreement with the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA), Office of Women's Business Ownership (OWBO).

Under the terms of our agreement with the SBA, JWBC is required to match federal funding received, on a dollar for dollar basis. As a program of the Chamber Foundation, ***all donations, sponsorships, or contributions to JWBC are tax deductible to the full extent of the law.***
